CODE OF CONDUCT 2019 - 2020

The code of conduct's purpose is to clearly identify the expectations for behavior for all Valley Warriors Special Hockey (VWSHP) participants. This includes players, parents, support staff, caregivers, coaches, officials, volunteers involved in VWSHP activities and events.

Valley Warriors Special Hockey is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. Participants of VWSHP are expected to conduct themselves at all times in a manner that reflects the values of VWSHP including fairness, integrity, mutual respect and most of all ensure our players are safe and having fun.

During all Valley Warriors Special Hockey Program activities and events, participants are expected to avoid behaviours that reflect on VWSHP in a negative manner. This includes, but is not limited to, use of violence, use of profane language, abusive use of alcohol, use of non-medicinal drugs. Participants shall not engage in any behavior that interferes with any player or team's preparation for competition or competition itself or that endangers the safety of others.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action decided by the coaches, coaching/player coordinator. Discipline could range from suspension from playing or participating in Valley Warriors Special Hockey Program events or dismissal from the program entirely.
